LEADERSHIP SERIES

Dr. Ramesh Babu



Dr. Ramesh Babu Thimmaraya, former Director and Head of Quantitative Research at Ernst and Young India, conducted an informative session on "Applied Quantitative Techniques" spread over two days on 30th July 2019 and 1st August 2019. Dr. Ramesh Babu gave his futuristic view on Artificial Intelligence (AI) and Data Science which was effectively utilized by companies like Ford, Google, and Facebook who are now the market leaders in their respective domains. He also talked about how the evolution of AI will replace people involved in mundane jobs by more efficient and highly trained robots.

Shri. Kamal D Shah

Shri. Kamal D Shah, Co-Founder and Director, Nephroplus addressed the students in the presence of the faculty on the topic "Challenges and Opportunities of Healthcare in India". He talked about the challenges of the healthcare sector in India where the contribution of public expenditure in the aforementioned sector is only a measly 1.2% of the GDP. With reference to the nephrology department, he said that, only 15% of the people in need of dialysis, get the treatment due to issues such as affordability, accessibility to quality healthcare, unavailability of qualified nephrologists and poor awareness. He also talked about the challenges faced by him during the expansion of Nephroplus. This session helped the students to realise that struggles are not the end, but there are many opportunities beyond them.

Mr. Avik Chatterjee, a Principal Consultant and Coach at ODA, took the time to train the batch of 2019-21 during a leadership lab. He's worked closely with more than 50 companies and their respective leaders. His teaching style was an amalgam of outdoor activities, classroom interaction between students on problem management and very interesting bits on his experience. The session had glimpses of the concepts featured in his TEDx talk on 'How the language we speak affects our future'.



SUMMER INTERNSHIP (SIP)


